Are you an active parishioner or school parent interested in contributing to St. Gabriel the Archangel Parish and Catholic School? Are you passionate about supporting Catholic education?

The St. Gabriel Board of Education leverages members' strengths to advise the School Administration and Pastor on recommendations and feedback with respect to educational goals, policies, and programs. Committees focus on policy, finance, communications, educational opportunities, safety, and technology. The Board also supports activities like school improvement planning and implementation, safety and crisis response, and outreach and recruitment (e.g. Back to School Night, Open House, Fund-a-Need at the Auction, Capital Campaign).

Members serve three-year terms, which start in May. They engage in different leadership and committee roles pertaining to their expertise to support parish goals. Board or committee meetings are held on the third Thursday of the month for 10 months a year at the school or rectory, with committees meeting as needed.
